We are delighted to bring you Aberdeen Science Festival; a celebration of STEM and cutting edge research happening here in Aberdeen.

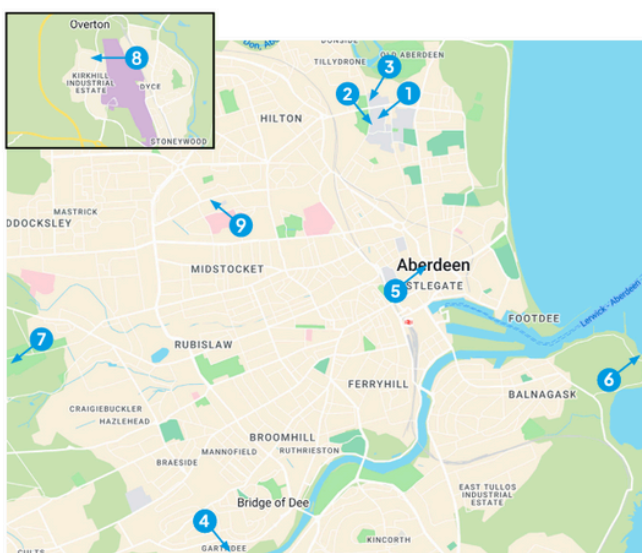
To help you plan your visit and make the most of your experience, we have created a handy guide on what to expect.

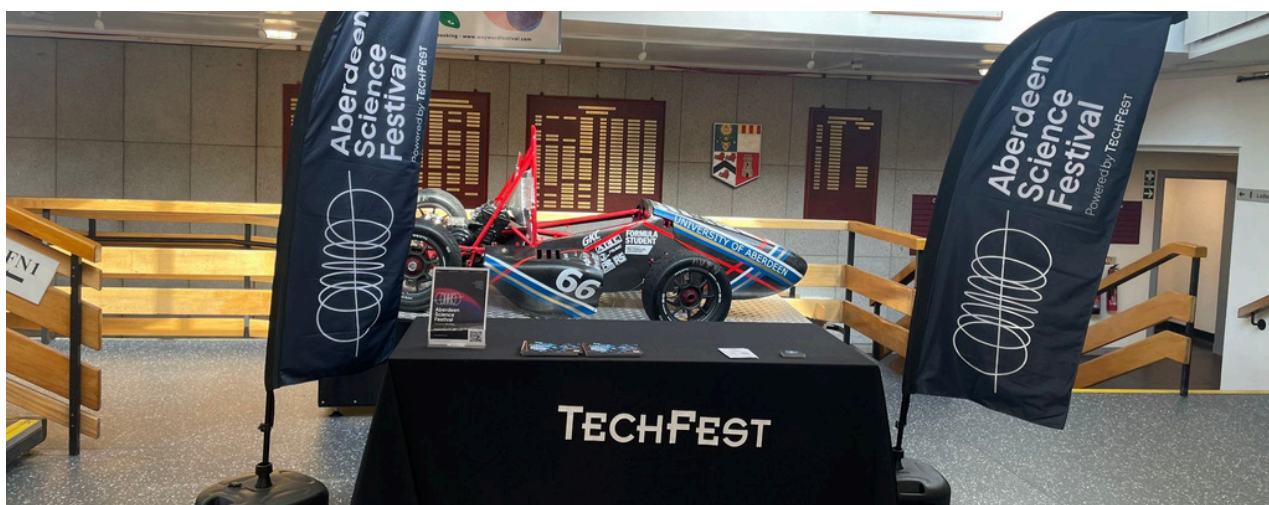
HOW TO FIND US

VENUE INFO

Our venues are situated across Aberdeen City and Aberdeenshire. We are delighted to be hosted by the University of Aberdeen and Robert Gordon University for many of the festival events.

Below you will find out more information on how to reach each venue and where to find the TechFest team.

At each event, TechFest will set up a reception desk inside the main door of the venue, here you will see our flags, banners and staff members ready to greet you and show you where to go. The reception desk will look something like the image below.

Fraser Noble Building

Elphinstone Rd, Aberdeen AB24 3UE

Nearest car park is at the Sir Duncan Rice Library which can be accessed from Bedford Road. Parking is permitted in university car parks after 5pm and at weekends when visiting the festival.



Zoology Building

Tillydrone Avenue, Aberdeen, AB24 2TZ

Parking is permitted in university car parks after 5pm and at weekends when visiting the festival

If you are visiting with a buggy or wheelchair, parking on the Chanonry and entering via Cruickshank Botanic Garden is much easier as it avoids stairs.

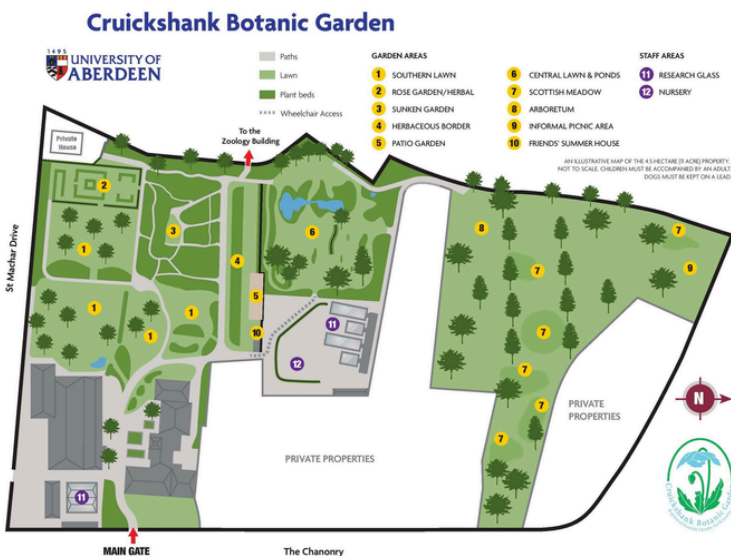

Parking is permitted in university car parks after 5pm and at weekends when visiting the festival

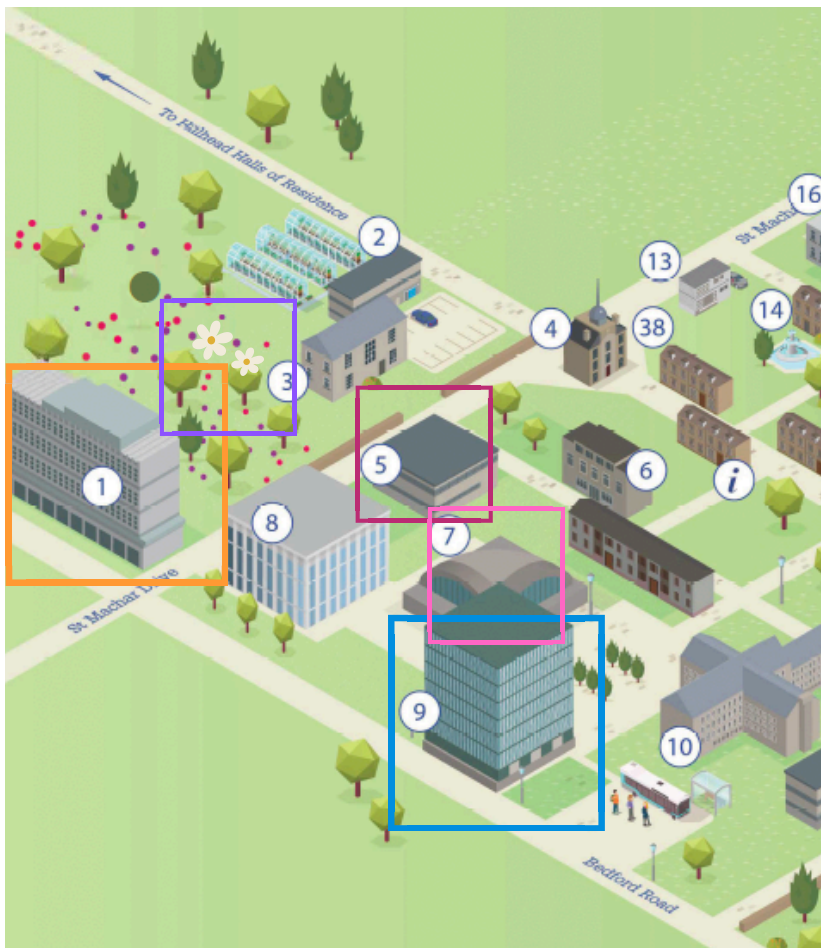

Stagecoach Bus

The number 60, 61, 62, 63, 67 and 68 Stagecoach buses run regularly from Union Square bus station and stop at King Street next to the campus. For more information on times and to plan your journey please visit the Stagecoach website.

Cash and card are both accepted. A single from Union Square to King Street is roughly £2.50

First Bus

The number 1, 1A, 2 and 20 First buses run every 7 minutes (or less during peak times) and go direct from various parts of the centre of town straight to the campus. You can also visit the First Bus website for more detailed timetables and information on planning your journey.

Please note: First Bus require exact change for their bus fares or accept contactless cards.

Parking is permitted in university car parks after 5pm and at weekends when visiting the festival.

Lemon Tree

5 West North Street, Aberdeen, AB24 5AT

You will find the Lemon Tree right behind Marischal College on West North Street. There is a bus stop right outside. If you are travelling by car, there are car parks at Frederick Street, Marischal College and the Gallowgate.



Greyhope Bay

Torry Battery, Greyhope Road, Aberdeen

Parking available on site.

Public Transport:

First Bus Route 12

Stagecoach Route 59

Stop at Nigg Bay Golf Club and walk 10 mins along grass path to north of golf club



Fierce Beer

Unit 60 Howe Moss Terrace, Dyce, Aberdeen, AB21 0GR

Plenty of parking on site, you can catch the airport bus out and it's a 15-minute walk to the brewery or you can get the train and a taxi from Dyce Station.

Meet at the Taproom – building next to 'Goods' in with the animal artwork on the outside.

Parking is permitted in university car parks after 5pm and at weekends when visiting the festival.

Travelling by bus: Many buses pass by the main entrance to the hospital on their way in and out of town including: First bus services 3, 4, 59 and X40, as well as Stagecoach services 10, 35 and 37.



Hazlehead Woods

Hazlehead Ave, Aberdeen, AB15 8BE

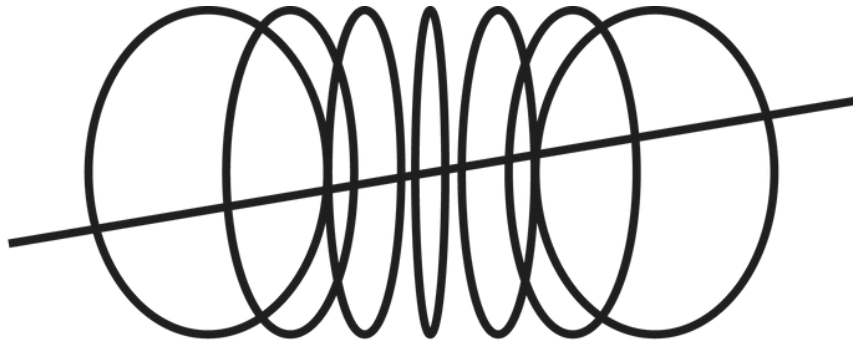
Parking available on site. There are 2 car parks accessed via Groats Road.

- Stagecoach: routes 4, 5, 6



FAQ

- **When is the event?** - The events take place from the 21st till the 28th of September, check out the TechFest website for more information
- **Where is the event?** - Most events are taking place at the University of Aberdeen Campus, others at Robert Gordon University. Be sure to check the location of your event before setting off.
- **How do I get to the venue?** - Many of the venues are accessible by public transport, but all have onsite parking available for visitors.
- **How early should I arrive?** - Please arrive 15 minutes before the the start time on your ticket. The events will start promptly.
- **What should I bring?** - Nothing is required! Some events may ask you to use your phone to take part in various activities.
- **Do I need to print my ticket?** - No, please have your e-ticket ready to show on your phone on arrival at reception
- **How do I register/buy tickets?** - Tickets are available online at Aberdeen Performing Arts or alternatively in person at the Aberdeen Performing Arts box offices at HMT or the Music Hall. Opening hours are 10am-6pm Tuesday to Saturday.
